ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES:

Scientific original research work can be presented in GPCON 2024 to be held on 7th and 8th December 2024 at Hotel Radisson Blu, Guwahati.

Categories:

1. Podium presentations : 5 minutes + 2 minutes discussion (Only original research works will be accepted).
2. Poster presentation: 4 minutes + 2 minutes (Original research work or case report or case series will be accepted)

Last date of submission of abstract : September 30th 2024.

Only one submission through mail id -

gpconassam2024@gmail.com will be accepted.

Only registered delegates can submit an abstract.

A delegate can submit more than one abstract (not more than two), but only one can be presented per delegate. If more than one abstract gets accepted, the presenting author may nominate a co-author to present the paper. The co-author has to be registered for the conference. The co-author has to have been included at the time of abstract submission. No co-author can be added later.

No table, figure should be attached with the abstract.

Do not mention the name of author(s) or institution in the Title, Body of the abstract. Mentioning the same will automatically disqualify the submission.

The abstract must be submitted along with the details of the author intending to present the paper as listed below:

1. Name of the person presenting the paper
2. Name(s) of the co-author(s), if any.
3. The name and address of the institution where the investigation was conducted.
4. The abstract should be written in Times New Roman style with font size of 12 with single spacing. Maximum word limit will be 250.
5. Size of poster during presentation will be 2x3 feet dimension in portrait layout.

Guidelines for GPCON best paper session:

Best 10 papers will be selected from all the submitted paper to be presented as podium presentation.

1. The presenting author must be registered for the conference.
2. The study should be largely his/her work.
3. The study should be done in India.

Travel Information

Guwahati is well connected by air and train with the rest of the country. From the metros and important cities, there are multiple direct flights.

Weather during December in Assam is pleasing, an ambience of typical tropical fall. The temperature remains in between 15° to 28° Celsius. Light woolen garments are required during the evenings.

Kamakhya Temple, one of the *devi-peeths* is a famous place to pray for the blessings and strength from mighty Goddess Kamakhya for the Hindus is situated in Guwahati.

Other attractions in and around Guwahati of touristic importance are Srimanta Sankardeva Kalakshetra, Suwalkuchi weaving village, an Evening Cruise in the River Brahmaputra, Balaji Temple, Dighali Pukhuri park with boating etc.

Pobitora Wildlife Sanctuary (famous for one horn rhinoceros) is near Guwahati and a safari can be planned from the venue hotel, with prior arrangement.

Chandubi Lake : At 60 km from Guwahati Chandubi Lake is a serene water body surrounded by dense forests and lush greenery, offering a peaceful escape. The lake was formed in 1897 during the devastating earthquake in Assam.

Kaziranga National Park (famous for the big fives) is 200 km away from Guwahati and a trip can be planned with one or two night's overnight stay.

Sivasagar (for the history and heritage enthusiastic) is at 2 hours drive away from Kaziranga (can be covered in a day trip from Kaziranga) was the seat of the powerful Ahom kingdom, the remains of which are evident in the magnificent Rang Ghar, Kareng Ghar, Talatal Ghar, Sivasagar Tank, Joysagar Tank, Gaurisagar Tank and Gauri-Dol. Another place worth visiting is **Charaideo**, about 30 km from Sibsagar town which retains the burial grounds of Ahom kings and queens and is also the sacred place of ancestral Gods of the Ahoms. These tombs (Maidams) of Charaideo hillocks are objects of wonder revealing the excellent architecture and skill of the sculptors.

Majuli, one of the largest riverine islands and the citadel of Vaishnavite culture is situated around 70 km from Kaziranga (about 300 km from Guwahati). It is a 924.6 square km freshwater island and declared the largest in the South East Asia. It is famous for its Vaishnavite Satras or monasteries and also is flocked by many migratory birds making it a bird watchers delight.

Dibru Saikhowa National Park is a bio-diversity hotspot further 300 km northeastwards from Kaziranga (about 500 km from Guwahati) famous for its semi evergreen forest, conserved to protect the rare White Winged Wood Duck and also has a large population of Water Buffalo, Feral Horse and Tiger-capped Langur.

Manas National Park, famous for the rhinos and tigers is 150 km away from Guwahati.
